What is it about?

SWAP Erasmus launches its Photo Competition to raise awareness on climate change. We invite students to capture what it means to live in a changing world under these two categories: climate change impact and climate change solutions.

- Students may show how climate change and/or human being interaction have negatively impacted their life, health, surroundings, nature, local economy or society.
- Students may also show how positive action can help stop or slow down climate change. How can community or individual action contribute to a better environment?

1. It's open to any student enrolled in any of the Secondary courses of the partner schools of the SWAP project.
2. Each photograph must be accompanied by a title (motto or phrase that depicts its environmental content).
3. All files must be named as follows:
SWAP PhotoContest_SchoolName_Surname_Name_Title.

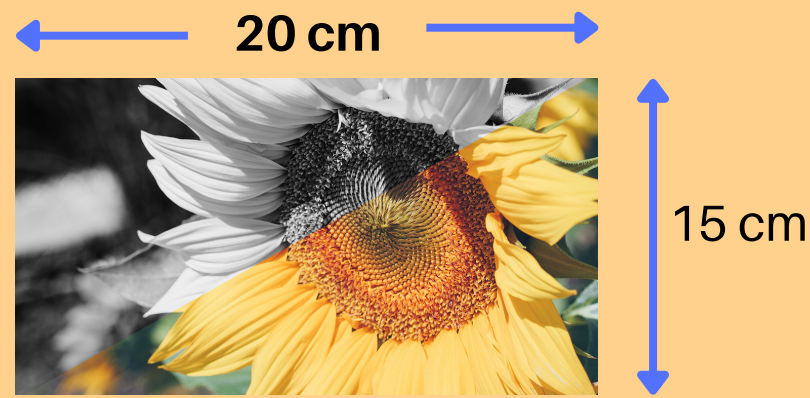


PRIZES:

There will be **3 winners**, each of whom will have **fantastic prizes**.

The photographs of the winners and the other 9 finalists will be exhibited in the hall of the Spanish school during the exchange week in April.

MINIMUM MEASURES



It can be either **black and white** or in **color**

Images should be no smaller than **1MB** and no larger than **5MB**, in **JPEG** file.

Key dates:

- Photographs submissions open between **March 10th, 2023 and March 31st, 2023**, both included.
- Jury's selection of 12 finalist photos between **10th and 14th April**.
- Photographs dissemination on Social networks between **17th - 21st April**
Winners announcement on the **24th April**.

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1. Students can submit a maximum of two original photographs on the subject. They must have full copyrights to the submitted material.
2. The photographs will be sent via email to the following address:
swap.erasmusproject@gmail.com.
Surname, Name, Level and School Name must be included in the email.
3. All the photographs will be uploaded and displayed in the twinspace.

1. A jury composed of teachers from the different departments will select the best three photos of each school, valuing the **aesthetic and creativity** of photography.
2. The final 12 photographs will be published in social networks. Students, **community and followers** can vote three photos.
3. The names of the final winners will be communicated through the **social networks** of the SWAP Erasmus project (Facebook, Instagram and Twitter), as well as on the website of each school.
